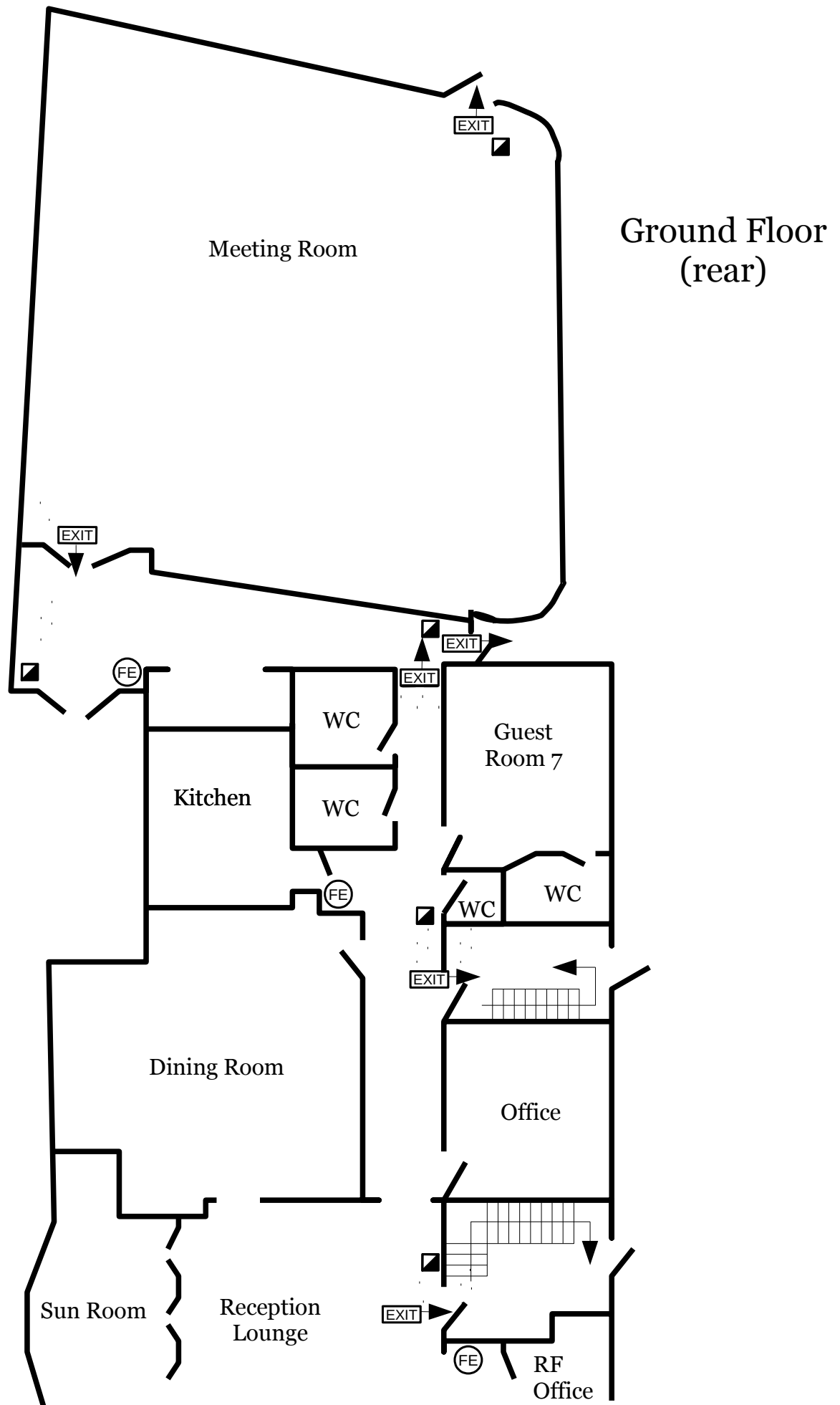
Manual Pull Station



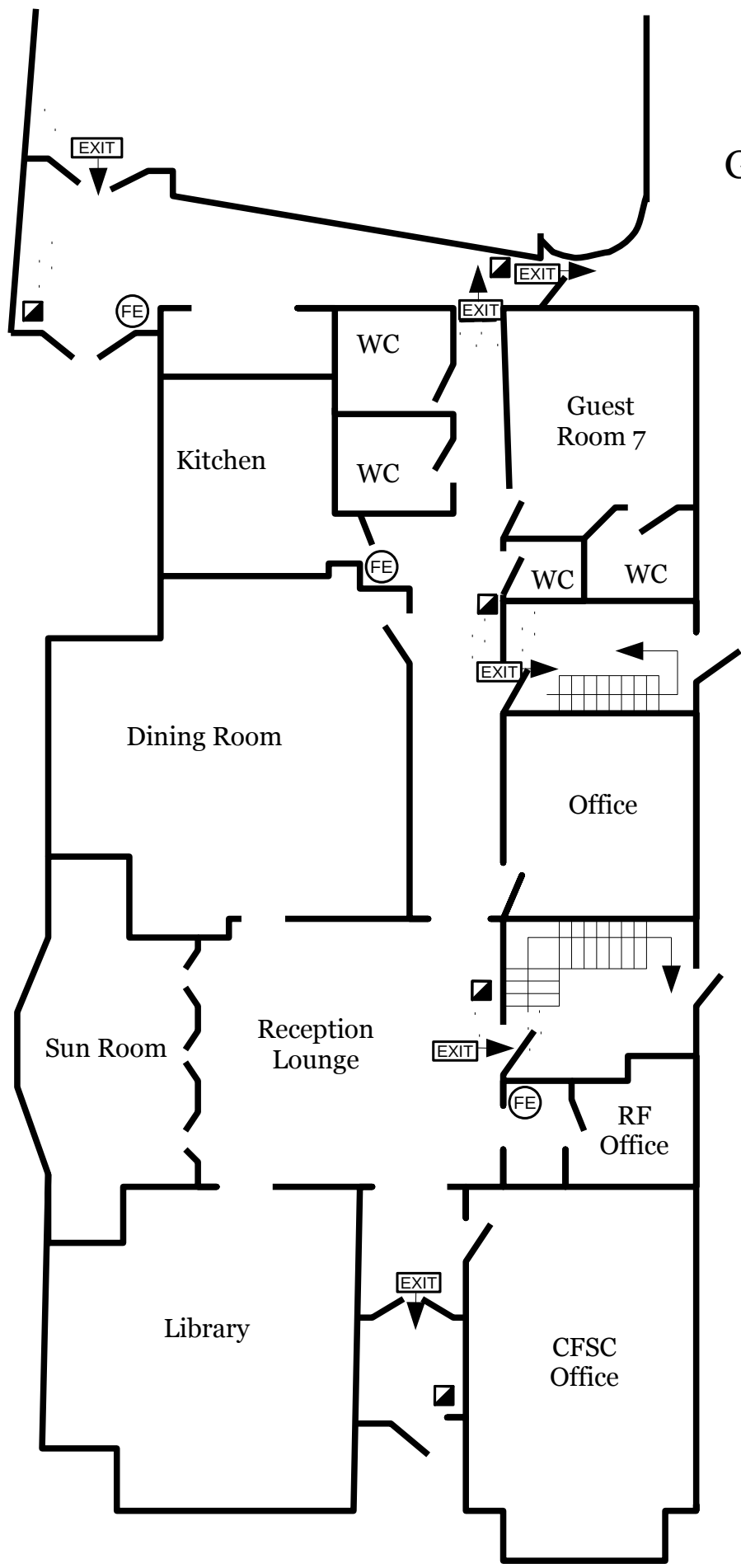
Exit

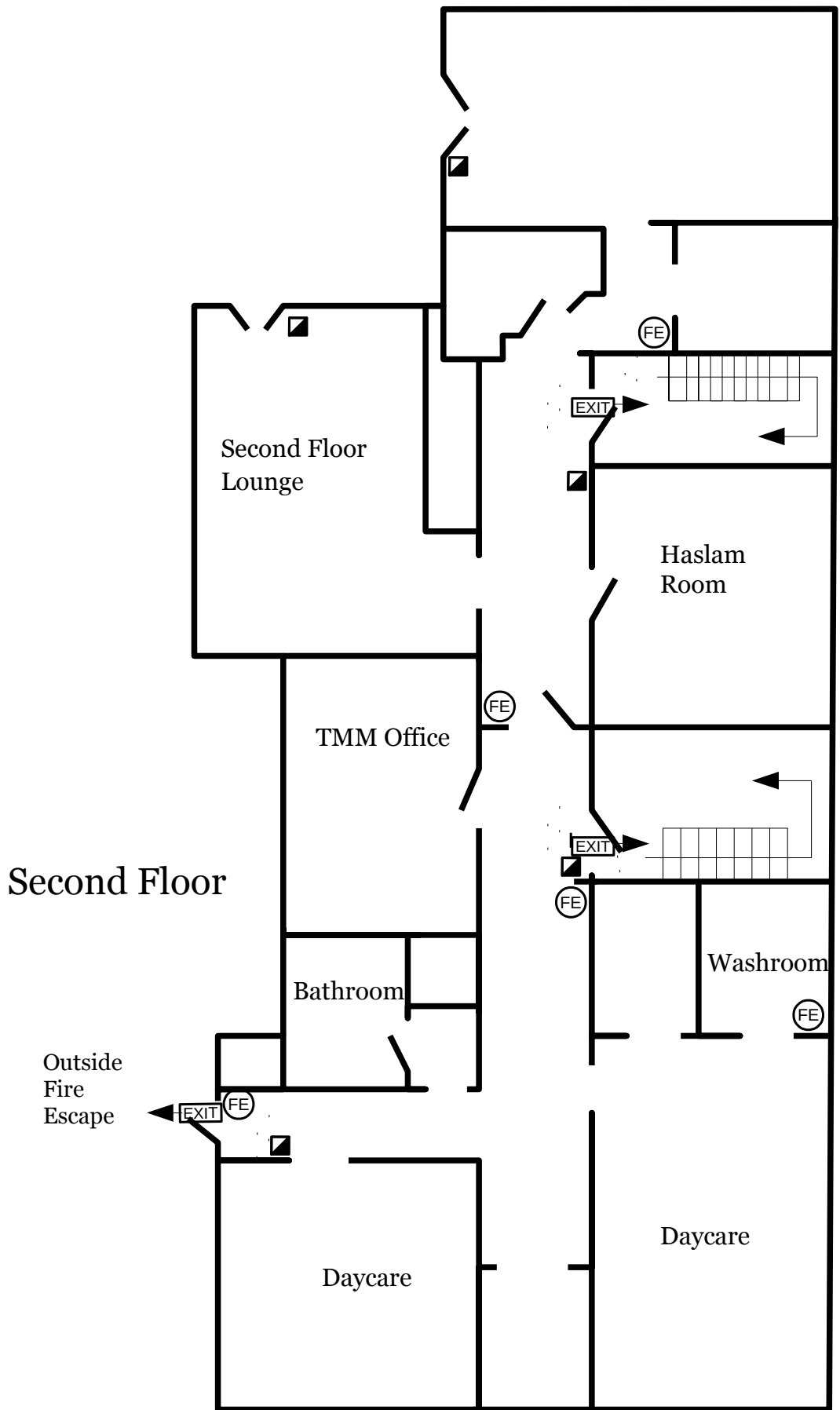


Fire Extinguisher

Fire Extinguishment

If there is a fire, occupants should not attempt to extinguish the fire themselves. The first priority should be to empty the House and ensure that no one's life is at risk. In order to do this:

- If the fire alarm is not already ringing, go to the nearest alarm pull-box and sound the alarm.
- Call 9-1-1 and report the fire. Give your name and the address of the house (**60 Lowther Ave**, not to be confused with 60 Bedford Rd, our neighbor on the east). If there is any risk, evacuate the building then find a phone and call the fire dept. at 9-1-1.
- Evacuate the building.

If after these steps have been taken, the fire can be extinguished by use of a fire extinguisher without danger, the Resident Friend or Associate Resident Friend may do so.

Visitors are requested not to operate a fire extinguisher and are on no account to forgo the opportunity to leave the House solely to attempt to extinguish the fire.
